## TOURNAMENT RULES:

We want to ensure that all teams are well-informed about the rules and regulations governing the competition. Please review the following official rules carefully to ensure a fair and enjoyable tournament experience for everyone involved:

## Alley-oop Basketball Tournament Rules

## First and Foremost

- The Tournament Director or a designated representative is the final arbiter of the interpretation and application of the Tournament Rules
- Decisions will be made in the best interest of the tournament and the safety and well being of the participants


## Game Rules

- Calgary High School FIBA rules will apply, except for the modifications that have been specified below.

Games Format:

- Warm up - 5-10 mins
- If the tournament is running behind, this will shorten your warm up.
- 1st half-24 mins
- 23 minutes run time last
- The last 1 minute will be stop time.
- 1 time out (Clock stops on Timeouts)
- Half Time
- 3 minute break
- During your half time break. One player from each team will get a chance to participate in the Half Court, "Splash For Cash" Contest. (1 shot only)
- 2nd Half-24 min
- 22 minute run time,
- The last 2 minutes will be stop time if the game is within 20 Points.
- 1 time out (Clock stops on Timeouts)
- Overtime-2 min
- No break in between the end of 2nd Half and the start of overtime.
- 2 minute stop time
- 1 time out (clock stops on timeouts)
- Additional Overtime - First to Score
- Starts with a jump ball
- No Break
- No time outs
- First team to score any point wins
- Special Rules
- As the referees are keeping the 24 second shot clock, offensive rebounds will have the shot clock set to 14 seconds. (We follow FIBA shot clock rules)
- Bonus starts on the 8 th foul - One shot for 2 points
- If fouled on a 2 point attempt - One shot for 2 points
- If fouled on a 3 point attempt - One shot for 3 points
- If fouled and the shot is made - One shot for 1 point
- Technical - Automatic 2 points and the ball at half
- Unsportsmanlike - Automatic 2 points and the ball at half
- No pressing at 20 point lead (this rule does not apply to HS Platinum divisions)
- Mercy rule is 40, stop keeping score on the clock and only keep it on the paper.
- No Zone defence in the U11 and U13 Divisions (Exception: If you have fouled out all your players and you are playing short a player)
- U11 Modifications

Foul line is 3 feet closer
No intentional double teaming or trapping of the ball
5 on 5 (Platinum & Gold)
4 on 4 (Silver & Bronze)
10 foot baskets (Platinum & Gold)
8.5 foot baskets (Silver & Bronze)
Pressing is allowed in Boys Platinum only
No zone defence allowed - We expect teams and coach's to play with integrity
to uphold the spirit of the rule.

## Forfeit Rule

- 5 minute Grace Period. (These count towards your guaranteed games)
- Because we do not collect a performance bond from each team. Any team forfeiting a game without extenuating circumstances (e.g., medical emergencies, family emergencies), may be removed from the tournament with no refund and is left to the discretion of the tournament organizers whether they may attend another Alley-Oop event in the future. It is not fair to the other team to not play your scheduled game. Final decision is left to the tournament organizers.

Technical Fouls

- 2 Technical Fouls is an ejection for players or coaches for the remainder of the game.
- If ejected, the player or the coach will be suspended for one game (Unless deemed otherwise by the Tournament Director)
- 3 Total technicals during the tournament will make the player or coach ineligible to participate any further in the Tournament. (unless deemed otherwise by the Tournament Directors)
- Technical fouls on players count toward there personal and team fouls
- Technical fouls on coaches will count toward the teams fouls
- Unsportsmanlike Conduct will result in a Technical (examples below, but no limited)
- Disrespect, Critical Remarks, Vulgarity, Profanity, Gestures, Negativity, Anger, violence.
- Player to Opposing Coach, Players, Refs, Scorekeepers, Spectators
- Coach to opposing Coach, Players, Refs, Scorekeepers, Spectators
- If spectators are disrespectful to Refs, Coaches, Players, Scorekeepers, etc. This will result in a technical foul being given to their team. They may also be removed from the facility. If a spectator is ejected, they are not welcome back into the event. (no refunds will be given)

Pool Play

- Tie Breaker Format:
- Better record
- head-to-head
- Total point differential in all pool games (max 20 points per game)
- Points against
- Coin toss

Overage Players

- There will be no overage players permitted unless they have been discussed with the tournament director.
- U-9: (2015-2016)
- U-11: (2013-2014)
- U-13: (2011-2012)
- U-15: (2009-20010)
- U-18: (Sept/2005, 2006, 2007, 2008)
- If a coach or program has a player's age challenged by tournament administration ONLY, they must show a form of government ID or birth certificate. If they do not have that present the player will not be able to participate and the team may be disqualified from the tournament.
- If you would like to Challenge the age of a player. It will cost 200.00 dollars. (If you win the challenge, you will be reimbursed)
- The Tournament Directors will make the final decision on discipline


## General Rules

- Players cannot play on multiple teams in the same divisions or for different club programs. Players may play in different age divisions if their club deems it appropriate. Example, a player may play on a U15 team and then be called UP (not down) to support their same club program's older team.

Recruiting Players

- Actively recruiting players from other teams is forbidden during the event. This includes using players and parents to speak to other parties. If an official report is submitted to Alley-Oop staff of a team, coach or player exhibits behaviour that demonstrates recruiting of players during the tournament, depending on the factors like past reports, intentions and severity, it may affect acceptance of that player, team or club into future events.


## Zero Tolerance Policy:

We would like to emphasize our commitment to maintaining a safe, respectful, and enjoyable environment for all involved. To uphold these standards, we have implemented a zero-tolerance policy regarding unacceptable behavior.

This policy applies to all participants, including players, coaches, officials, and spectators. We expect everyone to adhere to the following guidelines:

1. Respect: Treat all individuals with respect, regardless of differences in background, nationality, or skill level. Disrespectful language, gestures, or actions towards others will not be tolerated.
2. Fair Play: Play the game with integrity and sportsmanship. Cheating, dishonesty, or unsportsmanlike conduct will result in immediate disciplinary action.
3. Safety: Prioritize the safety of all participants. Any form of physical violence, aggression, or intimidation is strictly prohibited.
4. Compliance: Follow the rules and regulations set forth by the tournament organizers and officials. Failure to comply may result in penalties or disqualification.

6. Player Recruiting- Clubs/Coaches are not prohibited to engage in player recruitment during the event.

- Player ejection from the game
- Team forfeiture of the match
- Coach suspension or expulsion from the tournament
- Spectator removal from the venue
- Legal action, if necessary

## Refund Policy

2 Weeks No Refund Policy:

4 Weeks 50\% Refund Policy:

- Refunds requested between [Four Weeks Prior to Tournament Start Date] and [Two Weeks Prior to Tournament Start Date] will be subject to a $50 \%$ refund of the registration fees.
- Refund requests made after [Two Weeks Prior to Tournament Start Date] will not be entertained, except in cases of extenuating circumstances (e.g., medical emergencies, family emergencies).
